

Rejuvenating Our Precincts

The continual makeovers of our HDB estates are supported by estate renewal programmes carried out in close partnership with Town Councils and agencies. These programmes are necessary to bring the older estates closer to the standards of the newer ones for residents to enjoy a quality living environment.

Enhancing Precincts through Neighbourhood Renewal Programme (NRP)

The Neighbourhood Renewal Programme (NRP), serves to enhance common areas at the block and precinct levels with improved coordination and integration across neighbouring precincts.

Here on the right is an example of a NRP that will be implemented at blocks 12-14 Jalan Bukit Merah & blocks 35-40 Jalan Rumah Tinggi. Residents in these precincts can look forward to the upgrading of recreational facilities (i.e. fitness corner, playground & communal spaces with activity plaza), additional covered linkway & improved landscaping.

Other than NRPs, Town Councils also undertake smaller scale improvement projects in the HDB estates like the following.

The final enhancements will be determined through engagement with grassroots organizations and elderly residents.
