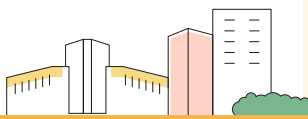
Cherished Memories, Close-knit Communities

The Remaking Our Heartland (ROH) programme was launched in 2007 as a blueprint to rejuvenate HDB towns and estates, and transform the heartlands into distinctive and enduring homes for residents.

Since then, nine towns and estates have benefited from the initiative – Punggol, Dawson and Yishun in 2007, East Coast, Hougang and Jurong Lake areas in 2011, and Toa Payoh, Pasir Ris and Woodlands in 2015. Ang Mo Kio, Bukit Merah, Choa Chu Kang and Queenstown are the latest four towns to be identified for renewal.

Queenstown is Singapore's first satellite town. With its rich history, Queenstown is celebrated for its distinctive estates filled with cherished memories and close-knit communities. The ROH programme will bring about enhancements to better meet the changing needs of the communities. These enhancements will also be brought to Farrer Road Estate, which is located in the vicinity of Queenstown.

In drawing up the rejuvenation plans for Queenstown, HDB actively engaged residents and other stakeholders to seek their views.

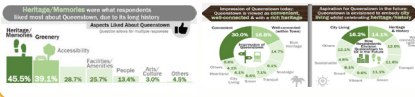

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Health District @ Queenstown

Queenstown ROH falls within the Health District @ Queenstown, a multi-stakeholder collaboration to create integrated solutions that will enhance the health and well-being of residents across their life stages.

Under ROH, science-backed built environment improvements will be rolled out so residents can lead healthy, active and purposeful lives. These will be complemented by community-driven programmes.



Queenstown will be rejuvenated under these 6 key strategies:

- New Homes For All**: New housing developments are designed with a variety of facilities to enhance residents' physical, social and mental well-being.
- Revitalised Public Spaces**: Improvement works such as new seating and barrier-free access will be introduced in neighbourhood centres to enhance residents' shopping experience.
- Enhanced Greenery**: New and enhanced parks will provide tranquil spaces for rest and mental recuperation, allowing residents to connect with nature.
- Enlivened Precincts**: Existing precincts will be rejuvenated with new exercise facilities to encourage all regardless of age and abilities to lead an active, healthy lifestyle.
- Active Connections**: Residents can look forward to better connectivity within Queenstown and a spread of active spaces along these key connectors.
- Cherished Memories**: To celebrate the treasured, rich history of Queenstown, heritage buildings and history murals will be woven into developments.
