
## FINANCING GREEN PROJECTS

### HDB's Green Finance Framework


The launch of HDB's Green Finance Framework and HDB's green bond issuances support the national movement to scale up sustainable development efforts in Singapore.

These projects are designed with a wide range of green and sustainable features, including solar panels to power common services, the Pneumatic Waste Conveyance System for more efficient waste disposal, and distinctive landscape design strategies that integrate greenery both on the ground level and on sky terraces and roofs.






# MORE SUSTAINABLE COMMERCIAL COMPLEXES

### Domain Targets to Reduce Carbon Footprint of Our Buildings

HDB is upgrading and designing our commercial premises to achieve 3 domain targets under the Singapore Green Plan 2030, Singapore's national sustainability agenda.

We aim to attain BCA (Building and Construction Authority) Green Mark Super Low Energy Certification for HDB's office and shopping complexes by 2023. We are also working towards the Green Mark Net Zero Energy (ZE)<sup>[2]</sup> certification.

Upon successful pilot of these buildings, we target to progressively roll out green initiatives at an average rate of 5 complexes per year.

[1] This refers to 60% energy saving above 2005 building codes which is being used as the anchor reference for Green Mark energy savings.

[2] SLE buildings with all energy consumption, including plug load, supplied from renewable energy sources, both on-site and off-site.
